The program will include several sessions covering the main areas of International macroeconomics. Anyone wishing to present a paper needs to submit it to a specific session.

Priority will be given to papers with original contributions and empirical applications that address a relevant economic question within the aforementioned topics. **All papers will be discussed by two different discussants.**
